THE RE-PUBLIC OF KENYA

is named after Mount Kenya. It's situated in East Africa, bordered by Ethiopia (N), Somalia (E), Tanzania (S), Uganda (W), and Sudan (NW). Its national motto is *Harambee*, which in Swahili means "Let us all pull together".

THE CITY OF GARISSA

is in the Northeastern province in Kenya. Most of its inhabitants are ethnic Somalis. The coldest months of Garissa are July and August. Not only was Garissa affected by the recent political turmoil, it's also struck by several floods.

Right about now you may be wondering, why am I going to Kenya? What will I do there? You may think that it's cool. Well, it is cool =). Supercool.

A team of 6 from our church will visit Garissa, Kenya in July. We will be hosted by Ken Ochieng, a missionary who works with Somali refugees and operates a school in Garissa. Ken and Hideyo, our associate pastor, met in a conference in Malaysia in 2006. After knowing Ken's school suffered from severe flood damages, Hideyo invited Ken to our church to share and fund-raise. During the 5 days Ken spent with us, he mentioned several times that he'd like for us to visit him and his ministry in Garissa.



During our 10 days in Garissa we will help out in the school, meet with many locals, and learn the Kenya spirit.

I am very excited about this eye-opening experience, but at the same time a little scared not knowing what exactly to expect. I'd like to ask for 5 people to commit to praying for me. Financial contributions are also appreciated. The trip costs around \$3,500, of which \$2,500 goes to the

plane ticket. I'd also like to ask you to commit to reading a piece of news regarding Africa or Kenya everyday during my 10 days in Garissa. Awareness is the first step for any change.

Prayer requests: growth during this trip; protection against dangers; Kenya political peace; helping the locals to cope with the aftermath of floods.
